Tell me about the course. During this course you will learn how to use a range of carpentry tools and safe working practices within the workshop. During the course you will be supported to design, create and complete a project using pallet wood to create a bird box, under the direction of your tutor.

Topics covered on the course will include:

- Identification of tools and materials.
- Using saws and chisel's
- Correct use of drill and bit
- Use of glue and fixings.
- Basic woodworking joints.

How will the course be delivered? This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

How will I know I'm making progress? During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan. You will review your targets regularly with your tutor to ensure that you are making progress.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? You will be expected to practise skills and prepare and plan for future sessions.

What will I need to take to the course? Please bring a pencil, tape measure and notepad. Please note that appropriate footwear that covers the whole foot is required.

What can I learn next? During the final session your tutor will discuss progression routes and follow on courses.
