The material fee will cover wool, crochet hooks, some patterns.

Entry requirements There are no entry requirements; this course is for complete beginners. People with a limited amount of knowledge on the subject may join this course to refresh their skills.

Tell me about the course This course will aim to demystify basic patterns and hook sizes and teach you how to create squares using a chain stitch foundation as well as the circle technique. Using the basic 'double' and 'treble' stitches, learners will work towards producing a range of small square panels which could be used to create a throw.

By the end of the course you will be able to:

- Understand hook sizes
- Create chain stitches
- Create a double crochet
- Create a treble crochet
- Change yarn colours
- Translate crochet abbreviations and symbols
- Make a traditional granny square

How will I learn? This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? You will need to practice between sessions (at least 2 hours per week) in order to develop your crochet skills and bringing in completed samples to join together in the final session.

How will I know I'm making progress? During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which will be reviewed regularly to ensure you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.
