The material fee will cover handouts and consumables for week 1 as well as access to dusts and colours for practise prior to purchase, and small cake cards for practise.

Before you enrol on this course Please be aware that Cake Decorating requires a range of tools, and weekly purchase/preparation of sugar, icing etc. Weekly advice will be given and if you do not bring the items on the equipment and ingredient list, your ability to complete activities will be impaired.

Entry requirements There are no entry requirements, this course is for mixed abilities.

Course description This course will support learners to use their own imagination to create a Christmas show stopper. Throughout the course learners will gain an understanding of how to design cakes using their own research and inspiration. Learners will be shown how to use a range of decorating techniques to achieve their creation.

How will the course be delivered? This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? It is always useful to practise the skills demonstrated between sessions, to perfect your technique.

What will I need for the course? Before beginning the course, you will need the following items:  
8 inch polystyrene cake dummy.  
10 inch cake drum.  
Container to bring dummy cake back and forth to class.  
Silicone Rolling Pin (20 inches).  
Small sharp knife and apron.  
Icing bag with nozzles  
Small watercolour type paintbrushes.  
2 -3 kg white Sugarpaste / roll out icing  
Please note that depending on your interests and designs, you may wish to purchase other items, your tutor will advise.

How will I know I am progressing?

During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan. At the beginning of the session, your tutor will demonstrate the technique in stages, you will then complete the activity and record your progress based on photos of your finished work. The tutor will give specific improvement points.
