The material fee will cover thread and fabric; zips and buttons; the use of sewing machines. All basic sewing equipment will be provided but you may, as your experience increases, want to buy materials of your own.

Entry Requirements There are no entry requirements, this course is for complete beginners. People with a limited amount of knowledge on the subject may join this course to refresh their knowledge.

Course description This is a relaxed and friendly course to introduce you to practical sewing skills that can be applied to clothes and simple soft furnishings. During the course you will build up a collection of worked examples to refer to once the course has ended.

The course will cover the following:

Advice on what to include in a sewing kit.
How to make a simple envelope cushion cover.
How to put in/replace a zip.
Sewing machine practise.
How to hem, sew up a seam and attach a button.
Information on relevant websites, books and both local and national events.

How will the course be delivered? This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions.

How will I know I'm making progress? During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which will be reviewed regularly to ensure you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need for the course? Please bring a pen, notepad and a file for your handouts. If you have a sewing kit please also bring it with you.
