Course description This course aims to introduce the functions of an SLR camera and basic concepts of photography so that you can gain an understanding of their use and be able to problem solve whilst shooting in auto modes.

We aim to cover the following:

Exposure, aperture, depth of field and shutter speed.
Previewing and deleting images.
Internal camera menu settings including, custom and shooting extras.
Downloading images and saving them.
Composition and understanding light.

How will the course be delivered? This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions.

How will I know I'm making progress? During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which will be reviewed regularly to ensure you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need for the course? Please bring your digital SLR camera with computer leads, manual and fully charged batteries. Please bring a pen and notepad.
