Entry requirements	This is a mixed ability class; beginners and those who have been drawing and painting for a while are welcome to enrol.
Course description	<p>During this course you will develop your ideas through exploring a range of source material and producing some experimental preliminary studies. You will be expected to bring in images and examples that you are inspired by to inform the development of your work. You will be encouraged to look at composition and use of line, texture and colour and experiment before deciding on a painting or drawing that you will produce as a final project.</p> <p>During the course you will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Develop your ideas from chosen source material.Develop your own way of working and personal style through exploring different approaches.Consider different compositions and colour combinations, through preliminary sketches, before deciding on what your painting will look like.Produce your final painting or drawing project (you may produce several final outcomes depending on available time and how much you are able to do at home).
How will the course be delivered?	This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.
Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom?	It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions.
How will I know I'm making progress?	During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which will be reviewed regularly to ensure you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.
What will I need for the course?	Please bring along drawing pencils and a rubber. You will be encouraged to use your own acrylic paints however there will be some available to use in class for the first few sessions.
Progression	There are other similar courses that you may be interested in. Please note that the fees for these vary and the eligibility for concessionary fees may be different.
