Entry requirements	This course is mixed ability for learners who have completed Watercolour Mixed Ability I and II. You should be able to mix colours from primary colours and know how to sketch.
Course description	<p>On this course you will continue to develop your skills in watercolour painting. You will study a wider range of subject matter and will be encouraged to blend different techniques to achieve specific effects. The tutor will provide exercises and resource material to practice and work from. You will also be encouraged to bring in source material of your own to develop your own style through experimentation and then produce a final painting for peer critique. You will continue to study the work of well-known artists for inspiration.</p> <p>You will learn:</p> <p>How to approach different subjects, agreed as a whole group, at the beginning of the course. This could include a seascape, landscape, portrait, abstract or still-life. How to develop your individual style of painting through experimentation and range of techniques and blending How to produce a final exhibition piece through the exploration of colour combinations, compositional arrangements and techniques</p>
How will the course be delivered?	<p>This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.</p> <p>Each lesson will start with a talk that will cover a specific technique or design consideration which will be incorporated into a painting or activity. The tutor will work closely with the interests of the group to ensure that learners are painting subjects that are inspiring and interesting.</p>
Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom?	It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions.
How will I know I'm making progress?	During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which will be reviewed regularly to ensure you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.
What will I need for the course?	Please bring a pen and notepad. You will need to bring your own set of watercolour paints and brushes. Your tutor will advise you on which paints and brushes are suitable, so please wait for the first session before buying the paints. Some paints and brushes will be available for the first session.
