Entry requirements This course is suitable for people who have either completed an Intermediate course, an Upper Intermediate course or have similar experience and wish to continue developing their language skills.

You should be familiar with the structure of the language including a range of tenses, including the conditional.

Tell me about the course This course aims to increase your ability to communicate with native French speakers on a wide range of topics using more complex French structures.

You will extend your vocabulary and knowledge of complex grammar structures, your reading and listening skills by various means including researching current affairs and preparing presentations, as well as discovering a range of colloquial phrases and how to use them in the correct context.

How will I learn? This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led group activities, instruction and repetition. These will improve your fluency and extend vocabulary. One-to-one support can be provided as required.
You will be encouraged to work more independently and develop your language skills away from the classroom. Grammar explanations and practice of tenses will be integrated into your sessions where necessary.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions. Many tutors email work out between sessions, so access to emails may be beneficial.

How will I know I'm making progress? During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need for the course? Please bring a pen, notepad and a file for your hand-outs.
