Entry Requirements This course is suitable for learners who have completed an Improvers course at On Course South West or at a similar institution.

It may also suit a learner who has returned to learning Spanish after a break, or someone who has lived abroad and is confident in common tourist situations and with using present, past and future tenses.

Course Intent During this course you will cover the following topics:

- Explain how you feel.
- Describe symptoms.
- Follow medical advice.
- Recognise key vocabulary used in complimentary medicine.

By the end of this course, you will be able to identify parts of the body in Spanish and use simple expressions to explain symptoms..

How will the course be delivered? You will be working with your tutor and other students online on Microsoft Teams. This will involve a regular video meeting every week, using the Microsoft Teams app, with supporting learning resources in the virtual classroom. We will supply you with a login and password when you enrol, and we can provide telephone support to help you to get into the virtual classroom on your computer.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? It is always useful to practice your skills between sessions. Your tutor may set some home learning for you to practice.

How will I know I'm making progress? Your tutor will set objectives for each session and give feedback on how you are progressing. You will agree personal targets as part of your Individual Learning Plan (ILP), and you will review your targets throughout the course to check your own progress.

What will I need for the course? You will need either a computer or a Smart device (phone/tablet) with reliable internet connection.

There are additional resources required for the course at an approximate cost of £10. Information will be provided at course induction.
