Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

#### What will I need?

Please bring a sketchbook (A4 or A3), set of Acrylic paints - including three primary colours, plus black and white. A selection of brushes, a range of pencils, a pen, ruler and an eraser. A roll of masking tape and a Pritt Stick too would be good to bring too. We will provide you with a kit containing most of those items. You may wish to bring a file for any handouts. A digital device with internet access is required for completion of coursework and home learning outside of the classroom (phone/ipad/laptop).

#### Please note:
