Course Description:

What will I learn?

Weeks 9-12: **Life Drawing & Thematic Exploration:** Focus on life drawing, mastering figure proportions and capturing movement. Introduce chosen thematic approaches like portraiture or landscape drawing (optional).

Weeks 13-16: **Advanced Media & Artistic Expression:** Explore advanced techniques in your chosen media, pushing boundaries and refining your artistic voice. Experiment with unconventional materials and explore personal projects.

Weeks 17-18: **Portfolio Development & Beyond:** Create a final portfolio piece showcasing your artistic growth and technical mastery. Explore resources for continuous learning in your chosen area of specialisation.

How will I be assessed?

Formative: Weekly projects, technique explorations, group critiques, and one-on-one feedback sessions will allow you to experiment, receive constructive criticism, and refine your advanced skills.

Summative: A final portfolio piece demonstrating your mastery of advanced drawing techniques, innovative use of media, and a cohesive thematic exploration in your chosen area (life drawing, portraiture, landscape, etc.).

Who is this course for?

This course is designed for experienced artists with a strong foundation in drawing who are eager to refine their skills and explore advanced concepts. (80 characters)

Progression Opportunities:

After completing this course, you can pursue specialisations within drawing (e.g., life drawing mastery, figure drawing intensive), delve into thematic approaches (e.g., advanced portraiture, detailed landscapes), or explore other artistic disciplines like painting or printmaking. Consider pursuing further studies in fine art programs offered by universities across the UK.

How will I know I'm making progress?

During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need?

Please bring a notepad, and pen to each session. You may wish to bring a file for any handouts. A laptop with internet access is required for completion of coursework and home learning outside of the classroom.

Please note:
