Develop your acrylic painting skills in a supportive, mixed-ability environment. This 18-week course will guide you through techniques, colour theory and creative exploration.

Course Description: Take your acrylic painting to the next level! This exciting 18-week course, perfect for those with some experience, will equip you with the skills and inspiration to create stunning artwork. Explore a range of techniques from colour mixing and layering to impasto and bold brushwork.

What will I learn?

Weekly activities are a suggestion and may be adapted based on the group's progress

- Weeks 1-4: Brushwork fundamentals, colour theory and mixing techniques.
- Weeks 5-8: Exploring composition, light and shadow. Introduction to different acrylic mediums.
- Weeks 9-12: Experiment with layering techniques, glazing and creating depth.
- Weeks 13-16: Develop your own style through creative projects. Focus on specific areas of interest such as landscapes, portraits or abstract art.
- Weeks 17-18: Refine your work, presentation techniques and final critique.

How will I be assessed?

- Formative assessment: Ongoing feedback throughout the course through practical exercises and discussions.

- Summative assessment: Completion of a final piece showcasing the skills and techniques learned.

Who is this course for?

This course is ideal for anyone who has completed a beginner's acrylic painting course or has some prior experience and is looking to develop their skills further.

Who is your target audience?

This course is designed for learners hoping to further develop their skills in acrylic painting and unleash their creative potential in a supportive and encouraging environment.

Progression Opportunities:

After completing this course, you could progress to:

- A more advanced acrylic painting course focusing on a specific style or technique.
- A life drawing or portraiture course to further develop your drawing skills.
- An independent art project or portfolio development scheme.

 - Fine Artist
 - Illustrator

How will I know I'm making progress?

During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need?

Please bring a notepad, and pen to each session. You may wish to bring a file for any handouts. A laptop with internet access is required for completion of coursework and home learning outside of the classroom.
