This course is perfect for beginners with no prior crafting experience. It's ideal for anyone who wants to learn new skills, explore mindfulness practices, and enjoy the company of like-minded crafters.

You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need?

Please bring a notepad, and pen to each session. You may wish to bring a file for any handouts. A laptop with internet access is required for completion of coursework and home learning outside of the classroom.
