- **Part 3 (Weeks 13-18):** Discussing art, literature & current affairs, expressing opinions in a persuasive way, arguing a point.
- **Part 4 (Weeks 19-24):** Formal & informal language styles, giving presentations & expressing yourself in public, writing emails & letters.
- **Part 5 (Weeks 25-30):** Debating social & ethical issues, expressing agreement & disagreement with nuance, cultural comparisons.

- Part 6 (Weeks 31-36): Idioms & expressions, advanced grammar structures, developing a sophisticated French vocabulary.

### **How will I be assessed?**

- In-depth discussions & debates on various topics
- Presentations & group projects to showcase communication skills
- Written assignments focusing on complex grammar & vocabulary application

### **Who is this course for?**

This course is ideal for learners with a good understanding of French grammar and vocabulary who want to achieve a higher level of fluency and communication skills.
