# **Course Description:**

The Green Protection of Natural Resources Skills Bootcamp is a 9-week program equipping you with the expertise to be a leader in environmental sustainability. Explore the principles of nature recovery, practise sustainable land use and agriculture, and implement green protection strategies. Develop skills for community engagement and education, promoting environmentally conscious practices. This course provides a strong foundation for careers in environmental protection, conservation, and sustainability.

## What will I learn?

- Weeks 1-3: Understand the principles of green protection, ecological restoration, and sustainable land management. Explore key practices for ecosystem services and green infrastructure.
- Weeks 4-6: Delve into sustainable land use and agriculture. Learn techniques for sustainable crop production, and discover agroforestry and sustainable forestry practices.

 Weeks 7-9: Develop a green protection strategy and plan. Learn to engage communities, promote sustainable practices, and implement effective environmental education programs. Explore green protection best practices and life cycle assessment for sustainable environmental impact.

#### How will I be assessed?

 A combination of coursework assignments, practical exercises, and presentations will assess your understanding and application of the learned concepts.

#### Who is this course for?

 This course is ideal for individuals passionate about environmental protection and sustainability. It's suitable for those with no prior experience or those seeking to upskill in this growing field.

#### How will the course be delivered?

This is a practical course, and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led group activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

## Will I need to practise outside the classroom?

You will be encouraged to review your notes between lessons to ensure maximum benefit from your course. It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions. Your tutor may encourage home learning, or independent research.

## How will I know I'm making progress?

During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

## What will I need?

Please bring a notepad, and pen to each session. You may wish to bring a file for any handouts. A laptop with internet access is required for completion of coursework and home learning outside of the classroom.

## Please note:

You need to be 19 or over to do a Skills Bootcamp. For most Skills Bootcamps, you do not need to have any previous knowledge in the subject. You just need to speak a good level of English and have a willingness to learn.

Most courses attract a subsidy from the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA).

It is a requirement of the ESFA that you complete various forms at different stages of your course, further information is available on request. Courses are fully funded by the Government for independent learners. Part of the price of a Skills Bootcamp may be required to be funded by the employer where an employer is upskilling one of their own employees.

Courses are subject to a minimum number of enrolments and could be cancelled if recruitment is low. In some cases, an alternative class at a different location may be offered.
