 - How to produce different effects using the laser.
 - Creating a final engraving.
 - Engraving edits and cuts.
- How will I learn?** This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led group activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.
- How will I know I'm making progress?** You will review your individual learning plan with your tutor who will give you written feedback and support to achieve your targets. This will enable you to identify any additional support requirements or areas to practise and revise.
- Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom?** It is always useful to practice your skills after a session.
