Who is this course aimed at? Everyone who has learnt Spanish and would like to convert their knowledge to a qualification.

Entry requirements If you can speak, listen, read and write to an advanced beginners level and beyond in Spanish then this course is for you.

Before you enrol You may be asked to complete an informal assessment to ensure you can achieve at this level.

Aims and Objectives Read simple messages including questions or requests for information on familiar subjects in the Spanish and produce a written response in Spanish  
Understand and use basic words and phrases in familiar situations. You will be able to take part in simple conversations, applying the basic rules of pronunciation and employing appropriate and commonly used conventions. You will begin to develop an awareness of the cultural conventions in Spanish.

How will the course be delivered? This is a practical course and the sessions will include tutor-led demonstrations, learner-led group activities, instruction and repetition. These will form part of the delivery together with one-to-one support as required.

Will I need to study or practise outside the classroom? It is always useful to practise your skills between sessions.

How will I know I am making progress? During the first session, your tutor will discuss your goals and current level in relation to the course. Based on this assessment, you will agree individual targets which you will record in your individual learning plan (ILP). You and your tutor will review your targets regularly to ensure that you are making progress; these will be written in your individual learning plan.

What will I need for the course? Please bring a pen, notepad and a file for your hand-outs.
