## Course Description:

This qualification is for learners wishing to qualify for the CSCS UK LTD Green Card to access construction sites in the UK as a non skilled worker.

**Please be aware that OCSW does not award a CSCS green card but gives you the knowledge through gaining this qualification to apply for one.**

Gain essential knowledge and skills in health and safety practices needed for the construction industry. Our Health and Safety in a Construction Environment Level 1 course is designed to provide participants with a fundamental understanding of health and safety principles specific to the construction industry. Over the course of two days, learners will explore critical topics such as hazard identification, risk assessment, and the implementation of safety measures. This course combines theoretical instruction with practical applications, ensuring that participants are well-prepared to maintain a safe and compliant work environment on construction sites.

What will be covered:

Day 1:

- Introduction to Health and Safety
- Overview of health and safety regulations in construction
- The importance of health and safety in the workplace
- Identifying Hazards and Risks
- Common hazards in construction environments
- Methods for hazard identification and risk assessment

Day 2:

- Implementing Safety Measures
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) and its proper use
- Safe practices for working at heights, handling equipment, and dealing with hazardous materials
- Emergency Procedures and Reporting
- Procedures for responding to accidents and emergencies

- Reporting incidents and maintaining safety records

### **Who should join this course?**

This course is ideal for individuals interested in employment in the construction industry who need foundational knowledge of health and safety practices.

### **Entry Requirements**

There are no formal entry requirements for this course, however experience in construction may be desirable and a good level of English.

### **Progression Opportunities:**

Learners can pursue further qualifications such as Health and Safety Level 2, Construction Site Supervision, or specialised training in Risk Assessment.
