This course prioritises participation and enjoyment over formal testing. Learning will be assessed continuously through observation and participation in games, ensuring a relaxed and engaging environment.

This course is designed for families and parents/carers who want to learn a new skill together and have some fun!

- **Teaching:** Using darts as a fun and engaging tool to teach basic maths concepts.

Please bring a notepad, and pen to each session. You may wish to bring a file for any handouts. A laptop with internet access is required for completion of coursework and home learning outside of the classroom.
